- In 1962, World War II veterans, Pete Seibert, Bill Brown and Bob Parker turned a tranquil sheep pasture into the now internationally famous Vail ski resort.
- When Vail's founders were deciding what to name the resort, some suggested Shining Mountain, which had been the name the Ute Indians had used for the area over the years. Instead they decided upon Vail, which was originally the name of the pass (Vail Pass) between the Gore Valley and Summit County.
- Vail had the first gondola in the United States, along with two double chairlifts and a beginner poma lift, serving six square miles of terrain.
